**Evelyn Lynn Teachers' Education Transfer
Endowment Scholarship
Fall 2012**

Application submission deadline: Friday, March 9, 2012

One scholarship in the amount of \$5,000 is available for continuing students who have graduated with an AA degree from Daytona State College and will enroll for at least 6 credit hours during their junior year at a Florida four-year public university (Refer to the list of eligible universities provided at the end of the application) in the semester for which the scholarship is sought (Applicant must provide proof of registration). Applicant must be enrolled in an education-related discipline and must provide proof of a passing score on the College Level Academic Skills Test (CLAST) prior to the semester for which the scholarship is sought.

Applicant must intend to obtain their K-12 teaching degree and certification within a two year period, and must meet all eligibility requirements to be employed as a teacher for the Volusia and Flagler County School Districts. Prior to initial award and as requested, recipient must obtain Level 1 clearance including: FDLE check, FBI fingerprinting, and substance screening paid for by this fund. All results must meet Volusia/Flagler County School Districts employment standards.

Scholarship recipient must intend to seek employment as a K-12 teacher within the Volusia or Flagler County School District for a period of at least one year immediately upon earning his or her

bachelor's degree and teaching certificate. Employment must commence as soon as a position is available.

Applicant must be a U.S. citizen, resident of Volusia or Flagler County (provide copy of driver's license or voter registration), maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA, and is making satisfactory progress toward program completion. Preference will be given to math, science, and exceptional student education (ESE) majors. Applicants who are members of the Florida Future Educators of America (FFEA) should identify themselves in essay. In addition to the submitting the application form, applicants may be required to interview for the scholarship.

Scholarship will be awarded as a multi-semester award, payable as \$1,250 per semester for up to 4 semesters for student enrolled for at least 12 credit hours per semester, or \$625 per semester for up to 8 semesters for a student enrolled for at least 6 but less than 12 credit hours per semester. Following receipt of initial award installment, scholarship recipient must provide evidence of satisfactory progress, as well as the next semester registration and fees statement to receive additional installments. Student must complete their degree within 2 years. Scholarship awards must be repaid if employment requirement is not satisfied.

- Incomplete scholarship application packets will not be processed.
- Applications will not be accepted after Friday, March 9, 2012, application submission deadline.
- Scholarship recipients must meet all scholarship conditions to receive the award.
- Scholarship applicants must have a minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA.
- Scholarship recipients must enroll in at least 6 semester hours during the semester for which the scholarship is sought.

You must attach an academic college transcript to your application form. Scholarship applicants must have a minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA.

Note: The Donor of the scholarship will select the scholarship recipient. Scholarship recipients must meet all scholarship conditions to receive the awards. Recipients of this multi-semester scholarship will receive subsequent installments only if the minimum criteria are met during the semester of the initial award. Scholarships are nontransferable and must be used at a Florida four-year public university during the semester awarded. (Scholarship recipients must be enrolled in classes and meet scholarship requirements during the semester for which the scholarships are sought.)
